Applicants seeking appointment at a level above Associate Professor must also complete a covering letter in which they identify the level of appointment they seek, and explain why they believe they meet the criteria for appointment at that level. These criteria are detailed below:

Criteria for Honorary Adjunct Associate Professor

An Honorary Associate Professor is expected to make a significant contribution to all activities of the Faculty of Health Sciences & Medicine and play a significant role within their profession or discipline.

They are expected to play a major role and provide leadership in teaching, research, scholarship and academic administration.

Academics at this level may be appointed in recognition of their academic excellence, as demonstrated by distinction in their disciplinary area, and their outstanding contribution to one or more of the following areas: clinical practice, research /scholarly activity, teaching, and professional activities.

Criteria for Honorary Adjunct Professor

An Honorary Adjunct Professor is expected to exercise a special responsibility in providing leadership in their discipline and profession, within the Faculty, the University and the community.

They should make a distinguished personal contribution and foster excellence in research, teaching, university service, personnel issues, professional activities and policy development. A Professor is recognised as a leading authority in their discipline.

Appointment or promotion to the rank of Honorary Adjunct Professor will be based on a distinguished academic career spanning years of substantial contribution to research and scholarship, and will require a demonstrable excellence and leadership in academic, teaching and professional achievement.
