## ABOUT OUR GUEST SPEAKER

Peter Stutchbury is one of Australia's leading architects, recognised nationally and internationally for his innovative approach to sustainability and design across a wide range of educational, industrial and residential projects. In addition to receiving an unprecedented number of Australian Institute of Architects Awards, in 2015 Peter Stutchbury was awarded the institute's highest honour, the Gold Medal for Architecture. The Jury described the winning Architect as having "mastered the art of creating architecture that speaks of the place it inhabits – buildings that are environmentally sustainable, culturally specific and locally embedded".

His firm Peter Stutchbury Architecture was established early 1981, in Newport, Sydney. Peter Stutchbury's appreciation of place and need for sustainability was formed by his experiences growing up in Cobar, western NSW. Mr. Stutchbury further developed his skills and knowledge through extensive travels across regional Australia, Africa, Asia, and Papua New Guinea; the location of his first project, a church in Port Moresby.

Peter Stutchbury has taught nationally and internationally. He is a Professor of Architecture at the University of Newcastle, and a founding director of the Architecture Foundation Australia. In addition, he has taught as one of the distinguished Masters at the Foundation's Glenn Murcutt International Architecture Master Class since its inception in 2001.
