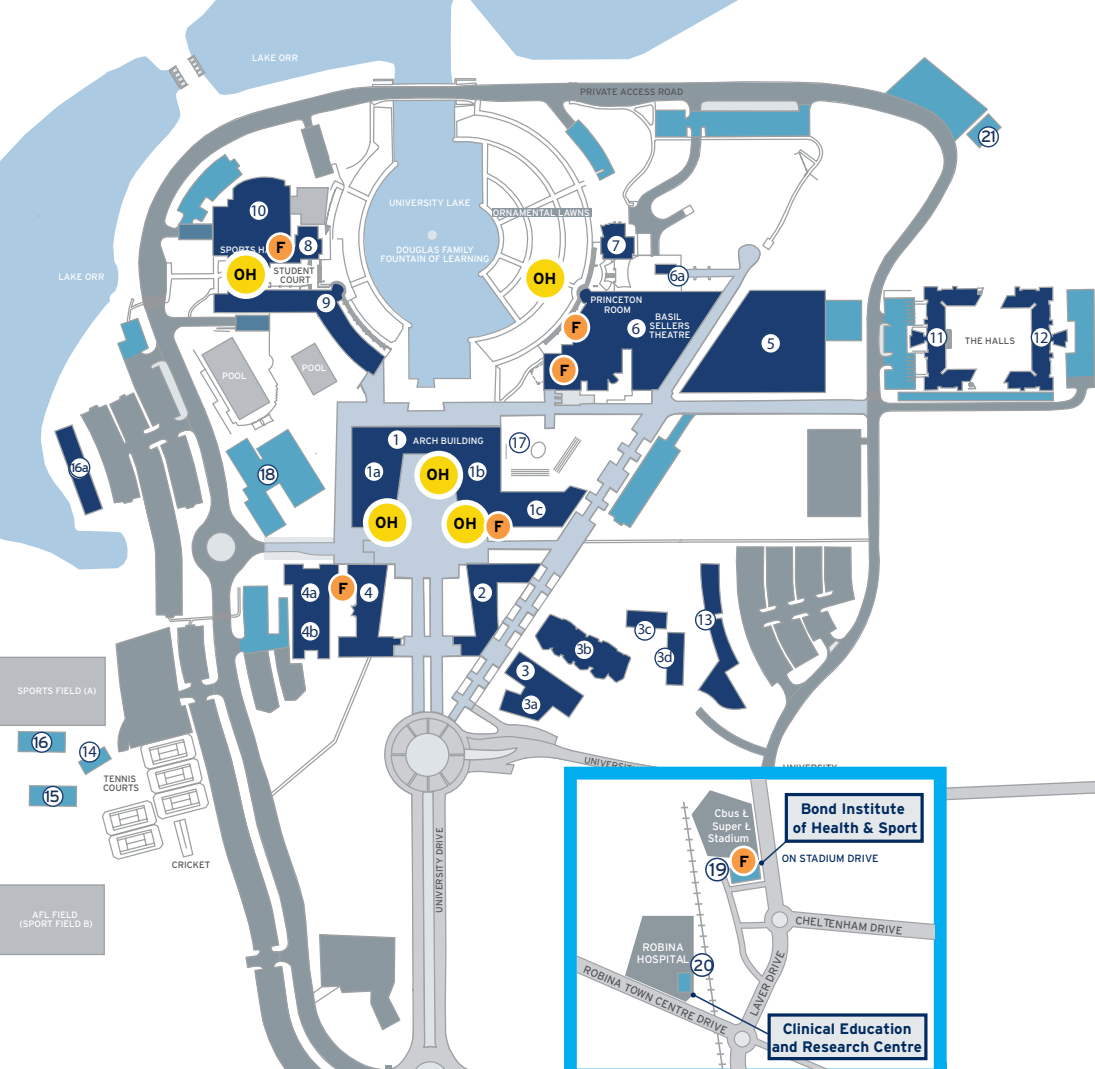

## Confirm your admission status

It always pays to check, right? When you arrive on campus for the first time, go straight to our Admissions Office in the Student Court - don't forget to bring your Response to Offer form and any documentation needed to enrol.
