



## ENTERTAINMENT NOISE GUIDELINES

This guideline is for use with events likely to produce excessive noise. Including those held outdoors; at night time; involving live music or amplified sound; and involving a large number of participants.

Under normal circumstances noise must not exceed 75dB(C), fast response, when measured approximately 3 metres from the primary source of the noise.

- Any outdoor event where noise is likely to exceed this level will be subject to approval by the General Manager Food and Beverage. Arrangements must then be made to have a nominated staff member monitor the noise output throughout the event, ensuring noise levels remain below the maximum noise range agreed to. This will vary based on factors such as time of day, location and nature of the event.
- Some events may also require a letterbox drop to residences in the immediate area notifying them of the possibility of excessive noise. This will be decided by the General Manager Food and Beverage and be the responsibility of the student group to distribute. It must contain the following:
  - ✓ The date and time of the event
  - ✓ That Bond staff will be monitoring the noise levels of the event
  - ✓ The time the noise will be reduced/music turned off as agreed with the General Manager Food and Beverage
  - ✓ Advising that complaints be directed to Campus Security 5595 1234
  - ✓ To be sent out on behalf of relevant student association identifying the student group organising the event
  - A Staff member is to be nominated to monitor noise and a mobile number for that person will be provided to security, along with details of the event.
