

Higher Degree Research Budget Information

In accordance with the <u>Higher Degree by Research Support Policy TLR5.10</u> HDR student project and travel funding is provided centrally through the HDR Unit (HDRU).

In order to ensure there is adequate funds to support a research project, all HSM HDR applicants are asked to provide a proposed research budget prior to enrolment - this budget is approved by both your supervisor and the Associate Dean of Research.

Whole of candidature budgets for new applications are <u>up to</u> a maximum of:
