With the lowest student to teacher ratio in Australia, our students have better access to and are more engaged with their teachers and peers. With fewer than 5,000 students, Bond is uniquely placed to ensure our international students get the most out of their overseas study experience.

## Job Ready Graduates

The embedded curriculum of the Beyond Bond program ensures every undergraduate student develops key employability and interpersonal skills through their choice of over 200 activities. These include internships, volunteering, participation in global competitions, and a broad range of extracurricular activities, available from their first semester.

As a small university, our Career Development Centre works with every student to arrange relevant internships, employer placements, work experience and industry projects throughout their studies.

Bond also offers Transformer, a free co-curricular program, which brings entrepreneurial students together from all disciplines to collaborate on projects from idea to execution. Working in teams, students have access to industry experts, mentors, workshops and a 24 / 7 co-working space.

## Graduate Sooner with Accelerated Learning

Bond's teaching calendar is based on three semesters per year (January, May and September) rather than the typical two, so students can complete a standard bachelor's degree in just two years.

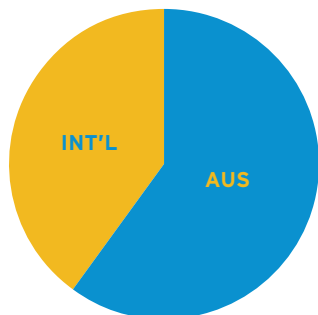

## Applying to Bond University:

For Australian and international students:

- Applications can be submitted online via our online application portal all year round, free of charge.
- Assessment is based on academic merit. References are not required.
- It takes approximately 2 weeks to receive an offer if eligible.
- Predicted grades are accepted for assessment. Official final grades are required to accept a conditional offer.
- Entry requirements for a standard undergraduate program at Bond University include:
  - International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma - 24 points
  - SAT - Score of 1020
  - GCE A level - 5 points (A\*=6, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1)
  - Minimum scores for other high school qualifications are available on our website
- Students that do not meet the minimum academic entry requirements can access pathways to study via foundation and diploma programs.
- The English requirement for most undergraduate degrees is IELTS 6.5 or equivalent. Graduates of international high schools may satisfy the English requirement by undertaking specific subjects such as IB English or including a letter from the school stating English as the Medium of Instruction with their application.
