



Selection Criteria - Assistant Professor – Professionalism & Medical Education

Essential

- A PhD qualification or equivalent in a relevant field is normally expected; an exception to this requirement may be made for individuals with extraordinary professional competence or clinical skills and experience.
- A commitment to high quality teaching and learning as evidenced by a well-articulated philosophy of teaching and evidence of positive student evaluations;
- Experience in curriculum, resource, program and/or subject design in medical education emphasising professionalism, including contemporary teaching methods such as application of educational technology, self-directed learning, small group learning, and varied assessment practices;
- A developing research profile including a planned and achievable program of research in a relevant field, that includes applications for research funding and supervision of postgraduate or coursework research projects;
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to engage effectively with students, stakeholders and colleagues within an interdisciplinary environment;
- Demonstrated commitment to participation in University marketing, recruitment or service activities, including participation on committees or in working groups;

Desirable

- A qualification equivalent to an Australian medical degree and registration or eligibility for registration as a medical practitioner in Australia
