1. OVERVIEW

Bond University is committed to maintaining a smoke free campus for students, staff and visitors.

2. THE POLICY

2.1. Application

This Policy applies to all staff, students, contractors and visitors to any Bond University Campus.

The use of [Smoking Products](#), including [Electronic Cigarettes](#), is prohibited in all areas including but not limited to:

- a) All University buildings including those denoted as student residences;
- b) Verandas attached to buildings;
- c) Covered walkways;
- d) Building under crofts;
- e) Emergency fire escape staircases;
- f) University vehicles;
- g) All indoor and outdoor areas except for [Designated Smoking Areas](#)

2.2. Compliance

Non-compliance with this Policy by staff and students will be dealt with in accordance with the normal disciplinary policies and regulations.

It is the responsibility of the University staff member who engages a contractor to inform them of this Policy. Contractors who do not comply with this Policy should be reported to the Campus Security Manager.

Bond University event organisers are responsible for informing visitors to the campus of this Policy. Visitors who do not comply with this Policy may be asked to leave the campus.

3. DEFINITIONS

Designated smoking areas Areas that are specifically approved by the Vice President Operations to be used for the purposes of smoking – refer to [Campus map](#).

Electronic cigarettes Include e-cigarettes, e-cigars, vapour pens or a personal vapour or any other device used for inhalation, exhalation or emission of a substance or any product where there is a hand to mouth action and results in the expulsion of a vapour.

Smoking Products Any tobacco product, herbal cigarette, loose smoking blend, cigarette papers, cigarette making machines, cigarette filters and electronic cigarettes.
