Proudly supported by key industry partners and global philanthropists, our scholarships are available to students who have excelled academically, in community endeavours and in leadership roles.

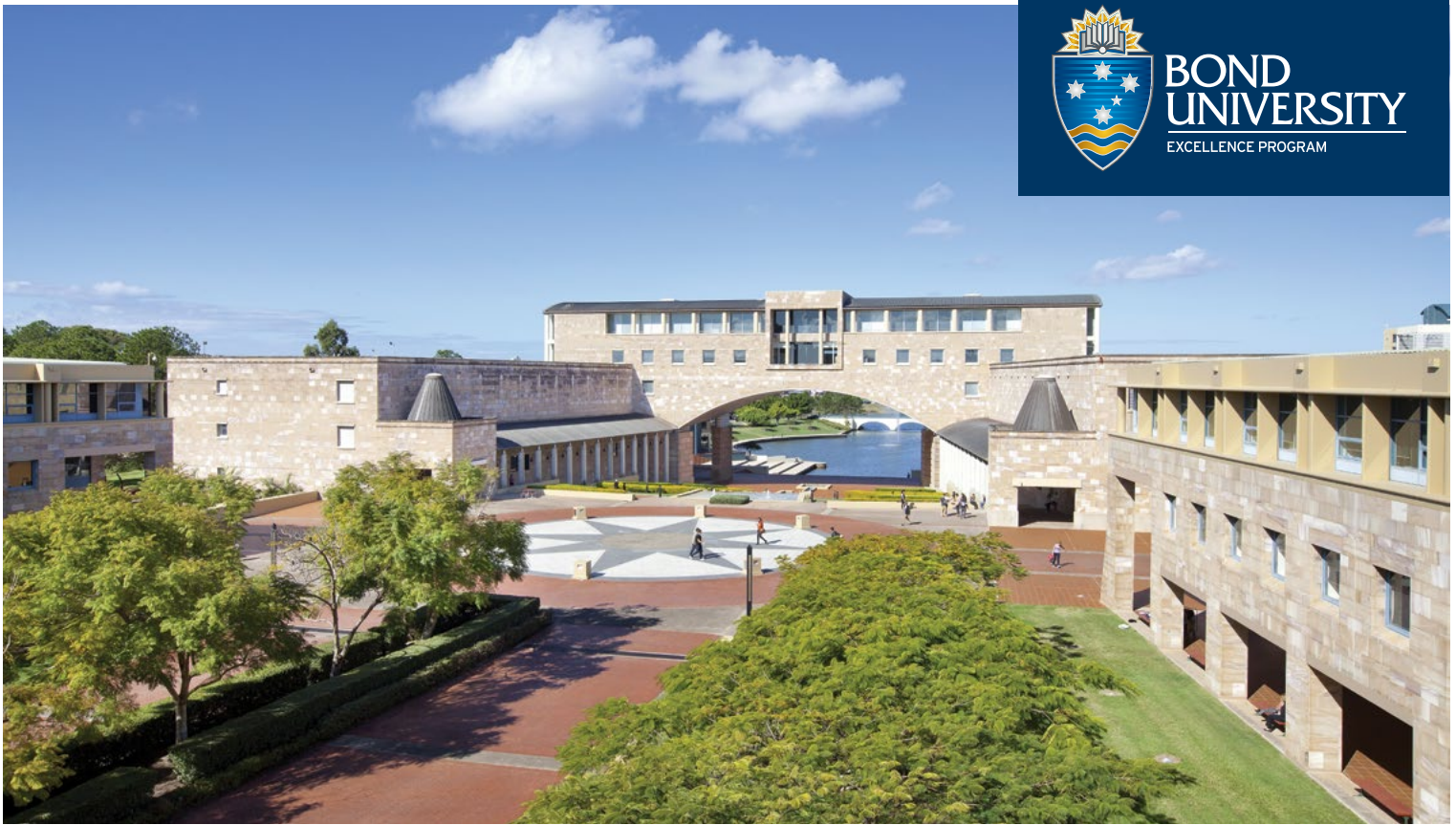
