



## INSOLVENCY: LAW AND PRACTICE

The Association of Independent Insolvency Practitioners (AIIP) in conjunction with the Centre for Professional Legal Education at Bond University are providing the 'Insolvency: Law and Practice' online course for employees of AIIP member organisations.

### The Course

The online course is designed for those employees who see themselves as Liquidators and / or Bankruptcy Trustees in the future. It is targeted for those employees who hold an undergraduate qualification and provides a pathway to articulate into a postgraduate qualification at Bond University.

### The Structure

The course is 100 percent online, however students will have access to the course coordinator for guidance.

It will consist of 10 modules covering the following topics:

- Introduction to Insolvency in Australia
- Insolvency Defined
- Compulsory Liquidation
- Meetings, Voidable Transactions and Preferences
- Receivership
- Bankruptcy
- Alternatives to Bankruptcy and Trustees Responsibilities
- Current Issues in Insolvency

### Modules

Modules will include instructional videos presented by industry leaders, self directed learning exercises, readings and plain English instructions. Assessment will be by way of multiple choice testing.

Modules may be completed at the participant's pace and require completion prior to moving onto the next instalment.

On completion of each module the participant will receive a certificate confirming completion and provide details of the CPD points earned.

After successful completion of all modules the participant will receive a Certificate of Completion issued jointly by the AIIP and Bond University.
