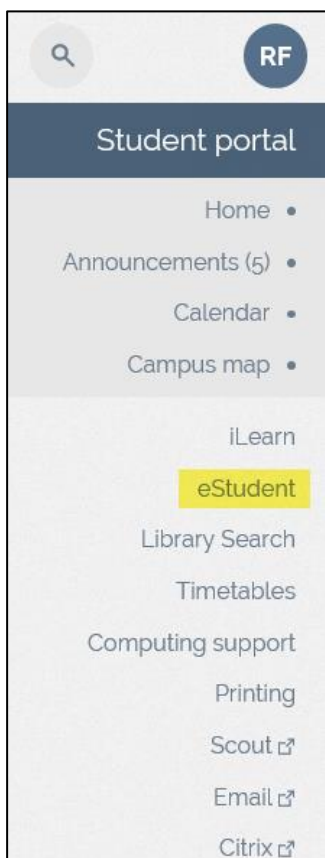
1. Sign in with Bond IT account

Username: Enter your student email (Bond email) i.e. @student.bond.edu.au

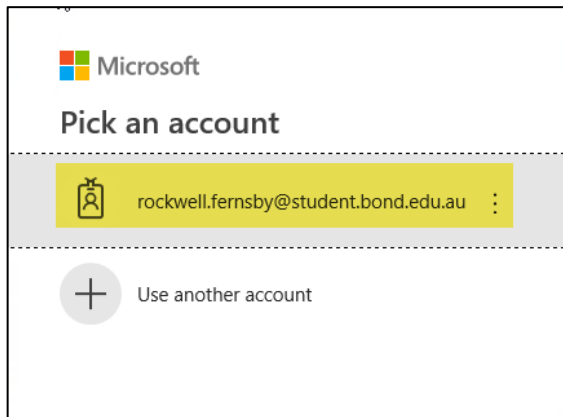
Password: Enter network password



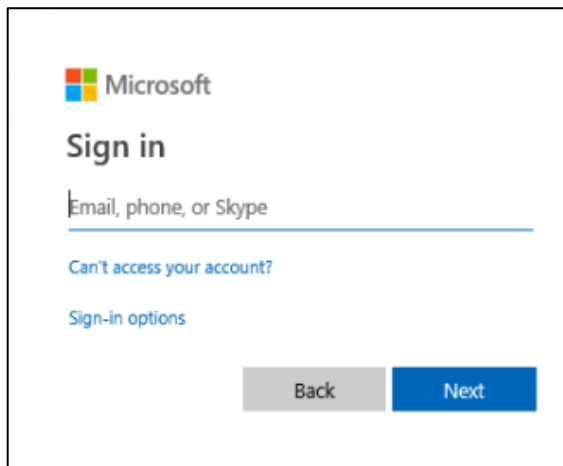
2. Click on Student Portal and select eStudent



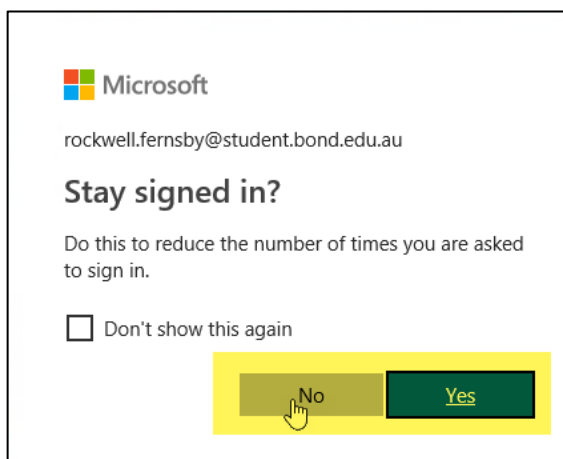
3. Select your student account (if displayed)

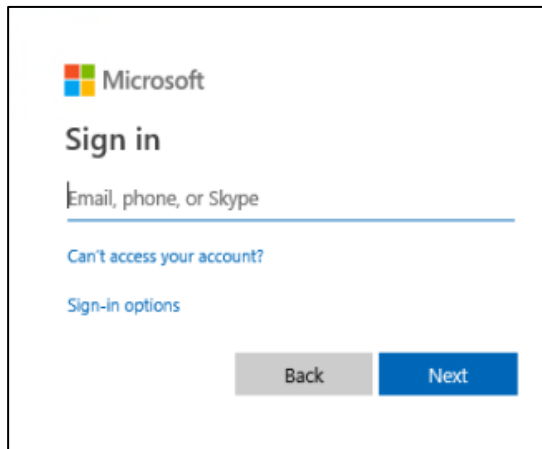

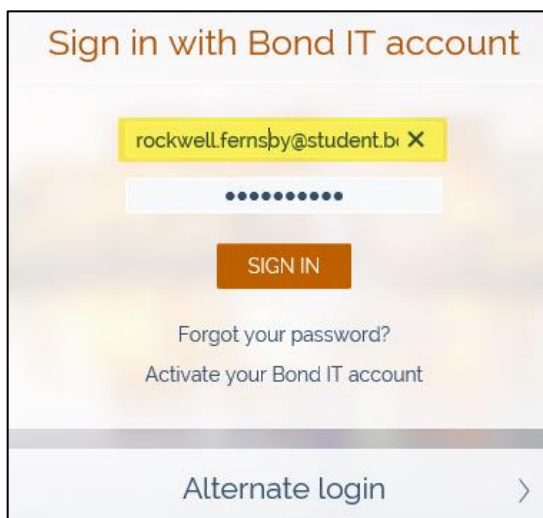


