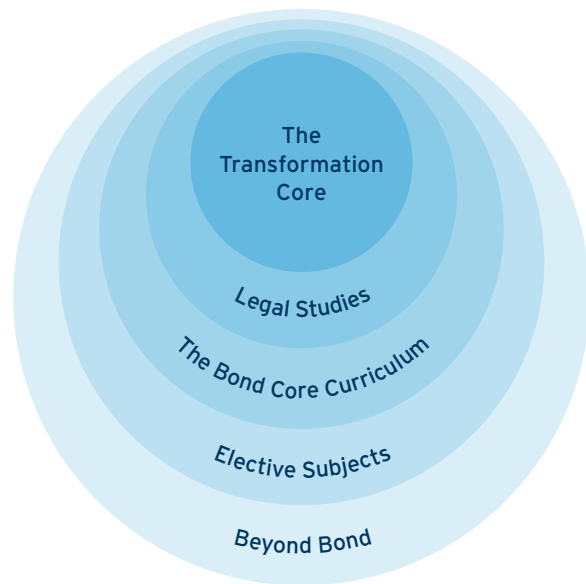


The details
