



SOP GTE Profile templates

As part of Bond University admission processes, required applicants are to submit a Statement of Purpose (SOP) addressing the Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) requirement as per the [Australian immigration authority guidelines](#).

To ensure efficient application processes, Bond University Admissions has created the preferred SOP GTE Profile template. Please note, this is a preferred SOP template for Bond University applicants to use, not a mandatory template.

There are multiple versions of the SOP GTE Profile templates tailored to whether the applicant is applying as a single or dual applicant and if they're required to package Bond University College English or Diploma programs with their primary Bond University program. The relevant SOP GTE Profile template will be issued as an attachment to the applicant's conditional offer. If you would like to submit the SOP GTE Profile as part of the initial application to assist with application processing times, please use the relevant template:

(S) = Single

(D) = Dual

(S package) = Single with package programs e.g., Diploma to undergraduate

(D package) = Dual with package programs e.g., Diploma to undergraduate

(S EAP) = Single with English package

(D EAP) = Dual with English Package

When submitting the applicants SOP GTE Profile to admissions via StudyLink, please name the GTE profile using the following format: 'SOP GTE Profile (the relevant profile) - Title & Name (year)'.

For example, 'SOP GTE Profile (S) – Mr. John Smith (2022)'
