

PROFESSOR AND HEAD OF PROGRAM – PHYSIOTHERAPY FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES AND MEDICINE

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. A doctoral qualification.
- 2. Physiotherapy registration (or eligibility) in Australia.
- 3. Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to interact effectively with colleagues, students and stakeholders.
- 4. Evidence of sustained experience in educational leadership, especially the management and development of academic staff, along with leadership experience in curriculum, resource, program and subject design including technology-enabled approaches to subject delivery in a physiotherapy program.
- 5. Experience with University budgeting, financial management and resource coordination.
- 6. A commitment to excellence and innovation in teaching and learning as evidenced by a well-articulated philosophy of teaching and peer recognition of teaching in the form of, for example, teaching awards and citations.
- 7. A sustained publication record along with evidence of successful research grants and HDR supervisions.
- 8. Significant and sustained contributions to marketing, recruitment, alumni relations or other service activities within the Faculty and University, including leadership roles on committees, in research centres or in working groups.
- 9. The ability to develop and maintain meaningful strategic partnerships within the Faculty, University and beyond with key stakeholders in the healthcare field.
