



Selection Criteria - Associate Professor (Level A or B) - Occupational Therapy (*Doctoral Co-ordinator and Research Performance*)

1. A PhD qualification in a relevant field; substantial progress towards a PhD in a relevant field;
2. Registration with AHPRA as an Occupational Therapist;
3. Excellence in teaching and learning within a context relevant to the role as evidenced by a well-articulated philosophy of teaching and student/peer evaluations;
4. Leadership in curriculum, resource, program and/or subject design in higher education, including contemporary teaching methods such as self-directed learning, web-based learning, small group learning, intensive-mode learning and authentic assessment practices;
5. Leadership in the governance of clinical academic programs including subject management, academic staff supervision, curriculum development, and clinical standards
6. A track record in research in Occupational Therapy as evidenced by scientific publications including peer-reviewed reports and research supervision including successful postgraduate research projects and/or HDR completions;
7. A record of success in applications for research funding;
8. Outstanding leadership, interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to engage effectively with students and colleagues within an inter-disciplinary environment;
9. Experience in engagement with stakeholders external to the university, including the capacity to liaise and build effective working relationships with healthcare partners and other stakeholders;
10. Significant and sustained contributions to marketing, recruitment, alumni relations or other service activities within a university context.
