



Selection Criteria for Professor/Associate Professor, Implementation Science and Healthcare Innovations

Essential Criteria

- A PhD qualification in a relevant field
- High level leadership, interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills along with the capacity to liaise and build effective working relationships at all levels with university staff and industry/health partners.
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching and learning within the context of healthcare education as evidenced strong leadership in curriculum, resource, program and/or subject design in relevant contexts and contributions to teaching and/or assessment within relevant existing subjects/programs.
- A strong track record in research as evidenced by peer-reviewed publications and research supervision including successful Honours, postgraduate research and/or HDR completions.
- Familiarity with current and future priorities in healthcare services and system development and contemporary approaches to implementation of research evidence into practice and policy
- Demonstrated ability to mentor, support and supervise staff in teaching and research.
- A track record of success in application for research funding

Desirable Criteria:

- Experience in conducting research projects, including as lead investigator is highly desirable, particularly for appointment at Professorial level.
- Desirable Criteria: Membership in relevant professional associations or societies.
