



SELECTION CRITERIA

Assistant Professor of Psychology

Faculty of Society & Design

Selection Criteria:

- A PhD in a relevant area of psychology.
- Registration as a psychologist with area of practice endorsement as a clinical psychologist.
- A strong teaching record including teaching and/or supervision at postgraduate level in Clinical Psychology.
- Evidence of experience in contemporary teaching methods such as self-directed learning, small group learning, web-based learning and technology enhanced learning.
- Demonstrated ability to supervise and mentor postgraduate students.
- Enthusiasm and a high level of communication skills both written and verbal.
- Cultural awareness and sensitivity in dealing with staff and students from diverse backgrounds.
- Strong research expertise within any subdiscipline of psychology, though preference for expertise in Clinical Psychology, and capacity to attract research funding through collaborative projects.
