

SELECTION CRITERIA

Assistant Professor A or B (Accounting)

Applicants are required to demonstrate evidence of:

- A PhD in a relevant discipline
- An emerging record of excellence in curriculum design and teaching of undergraduate and/or postgraduate accounting subjects including, but not limited to, Accounting Principles and Accounting Information Systems
- Proficiency in using active, experiential teaching methods.
- An established record of research publication in high-quality, refereed journals.
- Capacity to engage with relevant external stakeholders including industry practitioners and professional accounting organisations.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills and capacity to collaborate within a team.

The following attributes are also highly regarded:

- Prior experience as a supervisor of research higher degree students and/or success in securing research grant funding.
- Previous professional experience relevant to the role.
