SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. A doctoral qualification.
- 2. A commitment to excellence and innovation in teaching and learning as evidenced by a well-articulated philosophy of teaching and peer recognition of teaching in the form of, for example, teaching awards and citations.
- 3. A recognised reputation for research with sustained publication record along with evidence of successful research grants and HDR supervisions. For a professorial appointment an international reputation is expected.
- 4. Evidence of experience in academic leadership, including experience in curriculum, program and subject design including technology-enabled approaches to subject delivery in a biomedical science program.
- 5. Significant and sustained contributions to marketing, recruitment, alumni relations or other service activities within the Faculty and University, including leadership roles on committees, in research centres or in working groups.
- 6. Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to interact effectively with colleagues, students and stakeholders.
