

## Selection Criteria Assistant Professor in Law

## **Teaching focussed appointment**

- 1. Admission as a legal practitioner.
- 2. A current or recent practising certificate and experience as a legal practitioner.
- 3. A commitment to high quality teaching and learning as evidenced by a well-articulated philosophy of teaching and positive student feedback.
- 4. Experience in curriculum, resource, program and/or subject design, including technologyenabled approaches to subject delivery.
- 5. Active participation in university marketing, recruitment or other service activities within the Faculty and University, including participation on committees or in working groups.
- 6. Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to interact effectively with colleagues, students and stakeholders.
- 7. A doctoral qualification in a relevant discipline, or evidence of progress towards the completion of a doctoral qualification, will be highly regarded.
