



## **Selection Criteria Assistant Professor in Law**

### **Teaching focussed appointment**

1. Admission as a legal practitioner.
2. A current or recent practising certificate and experience as a legal practitioner.
3. A commitment to high quality teaching and learning as evidenced by a well-articulated philosophy of teaching and positive student feedback.
4. Experience in curriculum, resource, program and/or subject design, including technology-enabled approaches to subject delivery.
5. Active participation in university marketing, recruitment or other service activities within the Faculty and University, including participation on committees or in working groups.
6. Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to interact effectively with colleagues, students and stakeholders.
7. A doctoral qualification in a relevant discipline, or evidence of progress towards the completion of a doctoral qualification, will be highly regarded.
