- 1. Masters or Doctoral qualification in Clinical Psychology.
- 2. Registered Psychologist with Area endorsement in Clinical Psychology, plus Board-approved supervisor as Registrar program principal supervisor, Area of practice: Clinical psychology.
- 3. Successful supervision of postgraduate psychology students and/or supervision for Area of practice: Clinical psychology.
- 4. Extensive experience working with children and adults in psychological assessment and treatment.
- 5. Adherence to policies and procedures in a busy psychology clinic.
- 6. Maintaining high ethical and professional standards.
- 7. Enthusiasm and a high level of communication skills both written and verbal.
- 8. Cultural awareness and sensitivity in dealing with clients and/or students from diverse backgrounds.
