Essential

- 1. Bachelor of Medicine or an MD qualification with a minimum of 5 years' experience in the clinical field.
- Demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching and learning of clinical and practical skills at the university level, with a strong record of designing, coordinating and delivering high-quality, evidence-based education in simulationbased settings
- 3. Dedication to best practice in medical education, including simulation-based education (SBE), with relevant experience in delivering, and evaluating simulation activities.
- 4. Experience in overseeing, coordinating, mentoring, and coaching simulation staff and faculty such as simulation fellows, simulated participants, simulation casual tutors, and medical students undergoing their elective SBE placement.
- 5. Capacity to conduct research aligned with Faculty or Program priority areas, including a developing or established track record of research output and/or supervision of and MD higher degree by research students.
- 6. Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with a demonstrated ability to work collaboratively within a multidisciplinary academic team and engage effectively with internal and external stakeholders.
