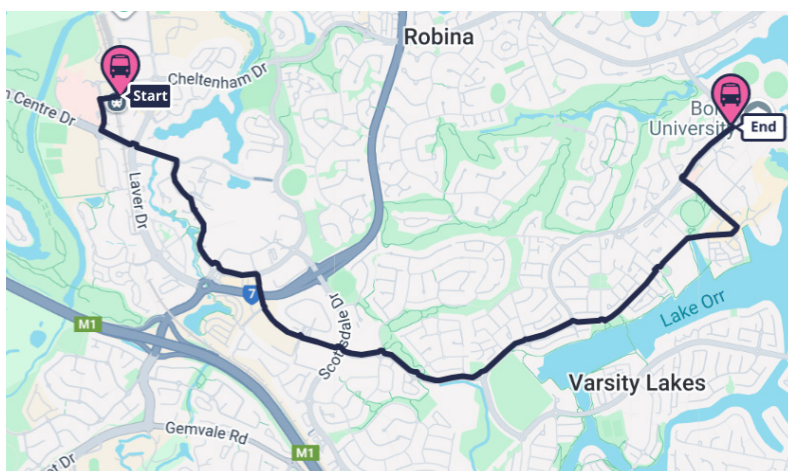
All students under the age of 18 are required to visit the Bond Start Hub during Orientation.

How room numbers work

Bond's rooms are labelled in the order of building number, followed by the level, and then room number. For example, 06_02_01 indicates Building 6, Level 2, Room 1.

Understanding the semester code

At Bond, we refer to each semester with a three-digit number. **The upcoming September 2025 semester is 253.** To work out the semester number, take the last two digits of the year (e.g. 2025 - '25') and the number of the semester (we're in semester 3, so use '3').

Parking on campus

Parking is free for all students at Bond with a valid digital parking permit. Register your details [online now](#).
