

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (A OR B) – CLINICAL PRACTICE TEACHING FOCUSED

SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential

- 1. PhD or other postgraduate qualification in medical education or other health-related discipline, with a minimum of 5 years of relevant professional practice, ideally integrating both clinical responsibilities and educational leadership.
- 2. Demonstrated experience in coordinating and delivering high-quality, innovative teaching and learning of practical clinical skills at the university level, with a strong foundation in contemporary, evidence-based educational methodologies in clinical practice environments.
- 3. Experience or ability to engage in curriculum, resource management, timetabling, program and/or subject design in teaching within a medical program including effective strategies and/or experience in facilitating group discussions ideally within a higher education or clinical environment.
- 4. Excellent interpersonal and group communication skills, demonstrating an ability to build, lead and sustain productive, multi-level working relationships within the university to foster safe and collaborate learning and working environments.
- 5. A strong commitment to active involvement in university service and governance activities, including a track record of impactful contributions to committees, working groups and/or accreditation processes that advance academic and institutional objectives.
- 6. Evidence of commitment to scholarship through research, evaluation of educational activities, publications, conference presentations or similar.

Desirable

- 1. Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) as a medical practitioner, nurse or allied health professional in Australia, or full eligibility to obtain such registration.
- 2. Experience in curriculum innovation and development, with proven capabilities in managing academic standards and guiding student progression at the undergraduate level within a higher education institution.
