



ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (A OR B) – CLINICAL PRACTICE TEACHING FOCUSED

SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential

1. PhD or other postgraduate qualification in medical education or other health-related discipline, with a minimum of 5 years of relevant professional practice, ideally integrating both clinical responsibilities and educational leadership.
2. Demonstrated experience in coordinating and delivering high-quality, innovative teaching and learning of practical clinical skills at the university level, with a strong foundation in contemporary, evidence-based educational methodologies in clinical practice environments.
3. Experience or ability to engage in curriculum, resource management, timetabling, program and/or subject design in teaching within a medical program including effective strategies and/or experience in facilitating group discussions ideally within a higher education or clinical environment.
4. Excellent interpersonal and group communication skills, demonstrating an ability to build, lead and sustain productive, multi-level working relationships within the university to foster safe and collaborate learning and working environments.
5. A strong commitment to active involvement in university service and governance activities, including a track record of impactful contributions to committees, working groups and/or accreditation processes that advance academic and institutional objectives.
6. Evidence of commitment to scholarship through research, evaluation of educational activities, publications, conference presentations or similar.

Desirable

1. Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) as a medical practitioner, nurse or allied health professional in Australia, or full eligibility to obtain such registration.
2. Experience in curriculum innovation and development, with proven capabilities in managing academic standards and guiding student progression at the undergraduate level within a higher education institution.
