



## **SENIOR TEACHING FELLOW – CLINICAL PRACTICE**

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

#### **Essential**

1. A qualification equivalent to an Australian medical or other health-related professional degree.
2. Experience and/or qualifications in medical education (in a clinical or related field), with a minimum of 2 years of professional background.
3. Strong commitment to high-quality teaching and learning, demonstrated through active involvement in contemporary university-level education, with experience in clinical practice teaching.
4. Proven experience in managing or coordinating practical learning activities, specifically involving students and tutors.
5. Exceptional interpersonal and group communication skills, with a demonstrated ability to build and maintain effective working relationships at all levels within the university.
6. A dedication to contributing to university service activities, including participation in committees, working groups or accreditation processes.

#### **Desirable**

7. Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) as a medical practitioner, nurse or allied health professional in Australia, or full eligibility to obtain such registration.
8. Experience in curriculum development, teaching, and managing student progression at the undergraduate level in a university setting.
