

SENIOR TEACHING FELLOW - CLINICAL PRACTICE

SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential

- 1. A qualification equivalent to an Australian medical or other health-related professional degree.
- 2. Experience and/or qualifications in medical education (in a clinical or related field), with a minimum of 2 years of professional background.
- 3. Strong commitment to high-quality teaching and learning, demonstrated through active involvement in contemporary university-level education, with experience in clinical practice teaching.
- 4. Proven experience in managing or coordinating practical learning activities, specifically involving students and tutors.
- 5. Exceptional interpersonal and group communication skills, with a demonstrated ability to build and maintain effective working relationships at all levels within the university.
- 6. A dedication to contributing to university service activities, including participation in committees, working groups or accreditation processes.

Desirable

- 7. Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) as a medical practitioner, nurse or allied health professional in Australia, or full eligibility to obtain such registration.
- 8. Experience in curriculum development, teaching, and managing student progression at the undergraduate level in a university setting.
