SELECTION CRITERIA

1. An entry level qualification in Physiotherapy.
2. Registered as a Physiotherapist with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA), with no restrictions.
3. Hold a valid Queensland Working with Children Card.
4. Experience working within an elite sporting environment, managing sporting injuries in elite athletes.
5. Comprehensive understanding and experience of rehabilitation principles, preferably within high performance sports/team environments.
6. A high level of proficiency in Physiotherapy assessment and interventions with complex health/physiological disorders in relevant athletes/client groups.
7. A high level of knowledge of Physiotherapy theories, models, and evidence-based clinical interventions with complex health/physiological disorders in relevant athletes/client groups.
8. A high level of knowledge of laws and ethical standards governing Physiotherapy practice.
9. Ability to work autonomously and collaboratively whilst displaying a strong commitment to work in a high-performance sports team environment, including the demonstrated ability to confidently and effectively work with colleagues in Sports teams.
10. Demonstrated ability to meet deadlines, effectively manage varying workloads, and respond to changing priorities as required.
11. Demonstrated high-level communication skills.
12. A high level of competence in the clinical supervision of Physiotherapy students in assessment and intervention with complex health/physiological disorders in relevant client groups.

DESIRABLE CRITERIA

- Postgraduate Musculoskeletal or Sports Physiotherapy qualification.
- Experience working with diverse populations and a demonstrated commitment to culturally safe practice.
