



**Selection Criteria:**  
**Casual Academic - Occupational Therapy**  
**Faculty of Health Sciences and Medicine**

**Essential:**

- A master's degree or higher qualification in a relevant field such as Occupational Therapy
- Full registration as an Occupational Therapist with AHPRA
- Substantial experience in Occupational Therapy i.e. Clinical background/experience in the following clinical OT practice areas: Ergonomics/ Work Rehabilitation/ Return to Work/ Vocational Rehabilitation, Neurorehabilitation, Indigenous Health or Mental Health.
- A commitment to high quality teaching and learning evidenced by:
  - successful conduct of contemporary university level teaching within Occupational Therapy professional programs and/or
  - experience in establishing, supervising and supporting occupational therapy / allied health students on professional placements.
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to engage effectively with students, stakeholders and colleagues within an inter-disciplinary environment.
- Availability to teach on campus and/or Clinical practice supervision
- Skills in digital technologies and information systems
- Availability to teach on campus and/or Clinical practice supervision
- Experience with stakeholder engagement, specifically liaison with healthcare partners
- Demonstrated commitment to participation in marketing, recruitment or service activities, including participation on committees or in working groups.

**Desirable:**

- Experience in curriculum, resource, program and/or subject design in higher education and managing student progression in Occupational Therapy professional programs
- A postgraduate qualification in a relevant field
