Selection Criteria

Essential Criteria

- A PhD qualification in relevant field;
- A commitment to high quality teaching and learning as evidenced by a well-articulated philosophy of teaching in the areas of building measurement and/or quantity surveying;
- Evidence of positive student evaluations;
- Experience in curriculum, resource, program and/or subject design, including contemporary teaching methods such as self-directed learning, web-based learning, small group learning, problem-based learning and varied assessment practices;
- A commitment to continuous improvement in teaching practice and performance;
- A planned and achievable program of research in any field of construction management that includes applications for research funding and supervision of postgraduate research;
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to engage effectively with students, stakeholders and colleagues within an inter-disciplinary environment;
- Experience with stakeholder and industry engagement, specifically liaison with professional organisations, government and community groups;
- Active participation in University marketing, recruitment or service activities, including participation on committees or in working groups;
- Hold membership of a relevant professional body such as the Australian Institute of Quantity Surveyors or be eligible for such membership.
