



Selection Criteria:
Assistant Professor / Senior Teaching Fellow of Clinical Exercise Physiology and Sport | Faculty of Health Sciences and Medicine

Essential:

- A Bachelor degree with Honours level qualification in a relevant discipline
- Accreditation as an Exercise Scientist (or eligibility to apply) with Exercise and Sports Science Australia (ESSA).
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching, supported by a clearly articulated philosophy of learning and teaching, and evidence of teaching effectiveness, such as student evaluations, peer review or learning innovation outcomes, commensurate with the level of appointment sought.
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and collaboration skills, including an ability to engage effectively with students, stakeholders and colleagues within an inter-disciplinary environment.
- Availability to teach on campus
- Skills in digital technologies and information systems that support student learning and/or course development
- Experience with stakeholder engagement, specifically liaising with industry and/or healthcare partners

Desirable:

- Relevant accreditation and credentials, including AEP (or ESSA eligibility) and ASCA Level 2 Strength and Conditioning Coach.
- Academic and practicum experience in Exercise Physiology, encompassing curriculum/program design, student progression, and practicum supervision.
- Demonstrated service and engagement, including participation in marketing, recruitment and/or committee or working group activities.

For applications for **Assistant Professor** level, candidates are expected to have completed a postgraduate qualification in a relevant field and evidence individual success in research, teaching and external engagement in the relevant selection criteria.
