The Graduate Diploma in Business comprises 40 credit points of Business Options and 40 credit points of Postgraduate General Electives, totalling 80 credit points over two semesters. The program develops broad business knowledge, management capability, leadership skills, and professional decision-making through a flexible selection of postgraduate business subjects and electives, providing a pathway to further postgraduate business study.			
Assumed Knowledge			
Assumed knowledge is the minimum level of knowledge of a subject area that students are assumed to have acquired through previous study. It is the responsibility of students to ensure they meet the assumed knowledge expectations of a specified subject. Students who do not possess this prior knowledge are strongly recommended against enrolling and do so at their own risk. No concessions will be made for students' lack of prior knowledge. Please check for all requirements on your subject outline prior to enrolment.			
Opportunities			
Students may have the opportunity to participate in an international study tour experience or internship as a general elective. Those interested should consult an Enrolment Officer in Student Assist for guidance and to check eligibility requirements (e.g., GPA, language proficiency, prerequisites).			
Additional Notes			
Students complete 4 business subjects drawn from the Bond Business School postgraduate offerings together with 4 general elective subjects, enabling both depth and flexibility within the curriculum. The business subjects introduce key concepts in management, marketing, organisational behaviour, finance, innovation, and decision-making, while the elective subjects allow students to broaden or tailor their learning across diverse postgraduate areas. This structure ensures students develop a multi-disciplinary understanding of business environments, gain exposure to practical case-based learning, and strengthen their communication, teamwork, and problem-solving capabilities.
