The Graduate Diploma in Sport Management comprises 60 credit points of Sport Management Options and 20 credit points of Postgraduate General Electives, totalling 80 credit points over two semesters. The program develops advanced knowledge and skills in sport management, including event management, sport law and governance, leadership, finance, marketing, innovation, and high-performance sport, preparing graduates for professional and managerial roles across the global sport industry.			
Assumed Knowledge			
Assumed knowledge is the minimum level of knowledge of a subject area that students are assumed to have acquired through previous study. It is the responsibility of students to ensure they meet the assumed knowledge expectations of a specified subject. Students who do not possess this prior knowledge are strongly recommended against enrolling and do so at their own risk. No concessions will be made for students' lack of prior knowledge. Please check for all requirements on your subject outline prior to enrolment.
